

Welfare & Safeguarding

We want all our students to feel safe and happy in London. At Burlington School, the welfare and safeguarding of our students is embedded in our ethos.



WELFARE TEAM

Burlington School and Residence has a multilingual management team. There is always a trained first aider and live-in supervisor, so students are cared for 24 hours a day.

ACCOMMODATION

Burlington offers a mix of single, twin, triple and multi-bedded rooms. Male and female students are always housed in separate rooms and, where possible, on different floors.

There are always live-in members of staff on site.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

We provide a transfer service for students arriving at all London airports and international terminals.

You will be met by one of the school's drivers, who will take you to your accommodation.

All our drivers have an enhanced DBS check.

STAFF

Our senior management team are available for all students to approach with any problems.

The school has a designated safeguarding lead who is supported by other qualified safeguarding people.

All our staff have an enhanced DBS check and hold certificates in safeguarding.

All our students who go on organised excursions outside of their classroom time are accompanied by at least one member of staff, depending on group size.

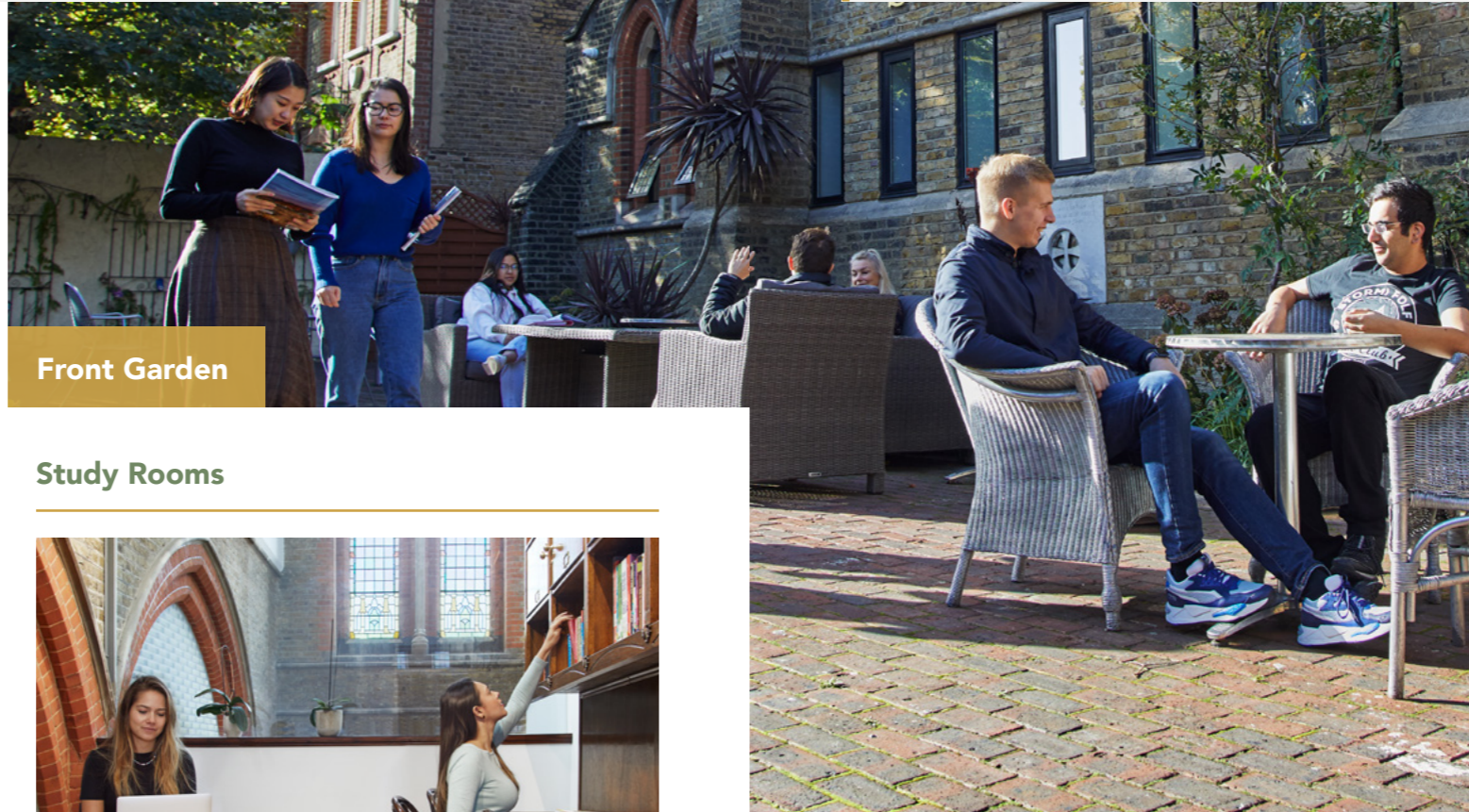

Wandsworth Apartment (Self-Catering)

Located just 10 minutes from the River Thames, our Wandsworth Bridge Road Apartment is a traditional 4-bedroom English student apartment in Zone 2.

Facilities and amenities include:

- large comfortable beds
- choice of ensuite or shared bathroom
- fitted kitchen
- free WiFi
- on-site laundry facilities
- communal cleaning services

The residence is located close to the shops and restaurants of Fulham and Chelsea Harbour. There are also shops and cafes just outside the apartment.

The apartment is just 30 minutes from the school by public transport. The nearest stations are Parsons Green (District Line) and Imperial Wharf (London Overground and National Rail), and there is a bus stop outside the front door.



Homestay

(Self-Catering, Bed & Breakfast, Half Board)

Homestay accommodation is an alternative option for staying in London, and gives you the chance to experience life in a British home.

Homestay providers treat the student as a full member of the household, eating together and sharing the common living areas. No more than four students stay in a homestay at any given time. Burlington School's homestay providers may be organised by the school directly or by a third-party accommodation agency.

SELF-CATERING

You will be given access to the host's kitchen to store your own food and cook your own meals (in accordance with household rules and times). For that reason, the host will not provide you with food.

Meals provided: None
Use of kitchen: Full use

BED & BREAKFAST

A continental breakfast will be provided (but not served) by your host. This usually includes toast, jam, cereal, tea, coffee and fruit juice. You are not generally allowed to use the kitchen to cook or store your own food. However, some hosts permit light cooking if specifically arranged when booking.

Meals provided: Breakfast (provided, not served)
Use of kitchen: None or light use

HALF BOARD

The host will provide you with breakfast (continental) and dinner. Where possible, you will usually eat dinner together with the host. You are not allowed to use the kitchen to cook, as meals are provided. Snacks are not included, but you can buy these and hosts usually can provide some storage space if requested.

Meals provided: Breakfast (provided, not served) and Evening Meal (served)
Use of kitchen: No use

Food - Coffee Bar

The Coffee Bar is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Snacks are also available during the day.

From morning till evening, our chef and the kitchen team know how to keep you full and happy with delicious and nutritious food, drinks and snacks for all your dietary requirements. Our homemade food is cooked daily, showcasing the best Burlington has to offer of local cuisine and added international flavours.

You'll love speaking English with your new friends, staff and visitors over a 3-course meal or coffee and cake – and listening to music (in English).

All our chicken, beef and lamb is Halal and so are most of our other products. You'll also love our vegetarian, vegan and other options.

General English

This course is designed for people who want to learn English for general work, study or pleasure. The classes focus on all aspects of the language: grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, speaking, listening, reading and writing.

All our lessons give you the opportunity to learn and use English to help you communicate in and outside the classroom. The course resources include a set coursebook, interactive technology, authentic materials and more. You will be assessed continuously to ensure that you are making progress and achieving your goals.

Term dates

We run four General English terms per year, and start a new coursebook each **January, April, July and September**.

IELTS Test Preparation

The IELTS course is for those who need an English certificate for work, study or immigration purposes. The course will give you confidence in exam techniques and answer any exam-related questions you may have.

You will build on your existing English and obtain a detailed knowledge of the exam format for you to gain the necessary skills needed to pass the IELTS. Classes focus on improving your grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation, as well as reading, listening, speaking and writing techniques, required for the test.









You will have regular authentic exam practice so you can track your progress and know when you are ready to take the exam. We can also help you to apply for the test at one of the local test-centres.

The social programme changes every week. Some activities are free whilst some incur a minimal fee of approximately £20 on average. The activities include cultural, historical and fun venues. They are based on events happening at that time of year. For example, at Christmas, there is a trip to Oxford Christmas markets and a pantomime. In March, come and watch the annual boat race along the Thames. At Easter take part in an Easter egg hunt.

In partnership with local tour companies, we organise day trips by minibus to further afield places such as Oxford, Cambridge, Windsor and Brighton. These cost an additional fee of approximately £50 on average.

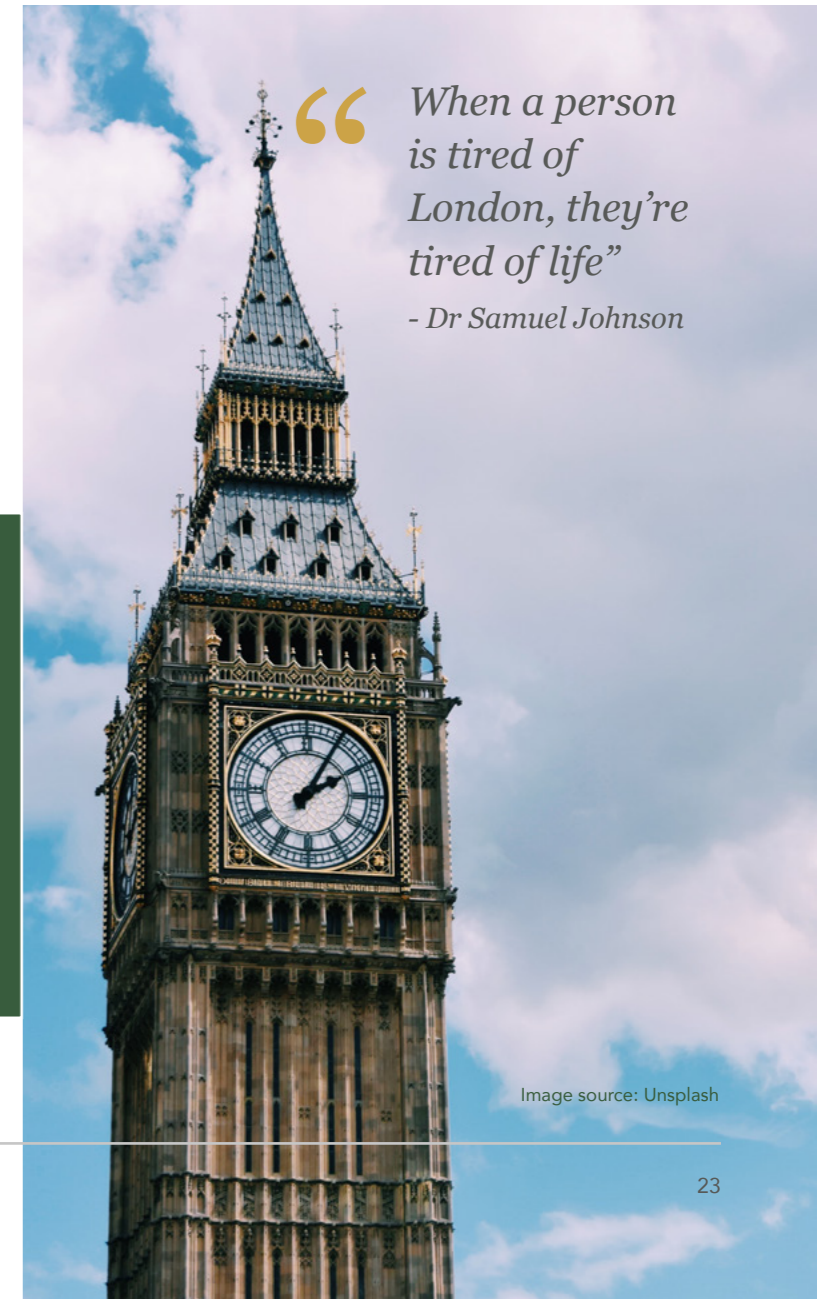

Age Groups and Levels

Our Young Learners take a grammar and speaking placement test and are then grouped according to approximate age and level. In general, we adapt our lesson materials according to the level, skills and preferences of people this age. Young Learners are aged 11-17 and should be at a minimum level of A2 (pre-intermediate), and be able to read and write using the English alphabet.

Academic Content

Assessment

Beside the initial placement test, Young Learners are also given ongoing assessment prior to being awarded a certificate of achievement at the end of their time with us.

Skills/outcomes include:

- 21st century intercultural communication presentations and digital skills
- Improved pronunciation
- Improved confidence
- Clear speaking with everyday English
- Community building, planning and organising skills

Students receive their very own Burlington Book of Memories to complete during their stay with us and to use as a portfolio of their work. They may also do video diaries, script-writing, hosting skills and a variety of other things according to the project they are working on.

Our Young Learners go on excursions to explore London and beyond, with their friends and classmates, and provide the opportunity to practise their English outside of the classroom.







