

Arriving in the UK

When you get to the UK, you will need to get from the airport or station. There are a few options.

Taxi transfer

This is the easiest option. A taxi will collect you from the airport and take you to your accommodation or destination.

If you prefer to travel alone from the airport or station, the following pages give you information.

From Heathrow Airport

There are 2 ways of getting from Heathrow by **train**:

- The Heathrow Express goes to London Paddington station. It is the quickest way to central London from Heathrow.
- The Piccadilly Line on the London Underground goes to Earls Court and Central and North London.



If you want to travel by **coach**, National Express has regular buses to London Victoria Coach Station. See <https://www.nationalexpress.com/> for more information.

From Gatwick Airport

Trains run from Gatwick Airport to these stations in London:

- London Victoria
- London Bridge
- London Blackfriars
- London St Pancras
- Clapham Junction



The fastest train is the Gatwick Express, which goes to London Victoria Station.

All these stations have good connections to the London Underground, local train services, and buses.

Arriving in the UK

From Stansted Airport

Trains go from Stansted Airport to London Liverpool Street station.

From Luton Airport

Trains go from Luton Airport to London St Pancras and London Blackfriars stations.

From London City Airport

There is a Docklands Light Railway (DLR) station at London City Airport. Trains go to Bank Station in Central London and Stratford Station in East London.



From London St Pancras

Eurostar trains arrive at St Pancras from European cities including Paris, Brussels and Amsterdam.

Trains also arrive from Gatwick and Luton airports, as well as cities around the UK.

London St Pancras has good connections to the London Underground, local train services, and buses.

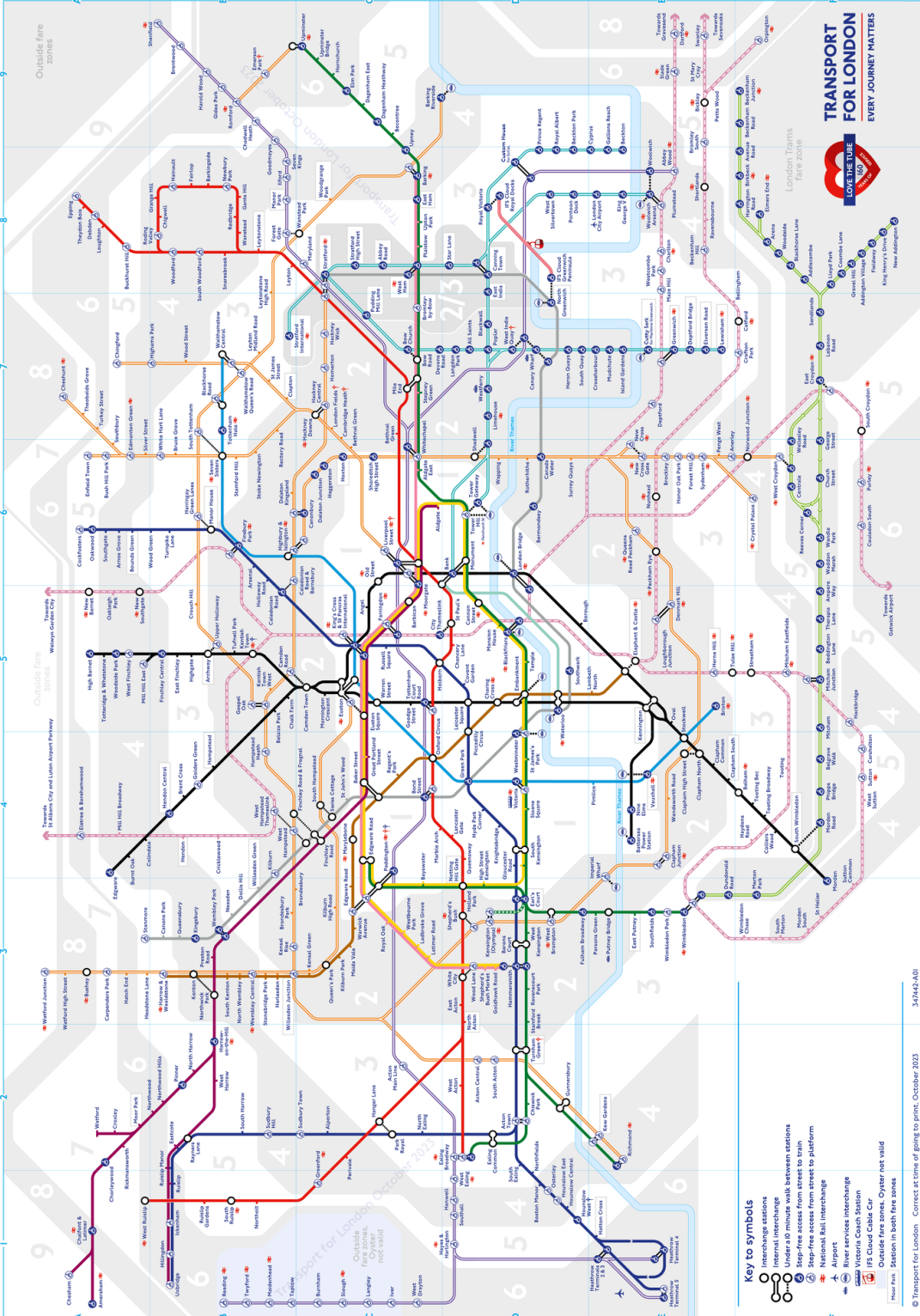
